We advise you to book your reservation as early as you can. Block is available through March 30, 2017. NO pet deposit will be required - BUT - any incurred damage will be "at cost" The Southwest Region will enforce the "TICA Hotel Room Inspection Procedures". Everyone reserving a room at the La Quinta in the group block acknowledges they consent to these procedures. Please wrap all used litter in plastic bags and discard (outside) properly. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: An official entry form or facsimile must be used for each entry and a completed summary sheet and full payment (U.S. Funds only) must accompany these entry blanks. E-mail or fax entries will be accepted, but will not be officially entered until full payment is received. If payment is not received within 10 days of email/fax entry, entry will become null and void. There will be no one-day entries.

CLERKS/STEWARDS: Please indicate on the summary sheet if you are interested in clerking for the show. Clerks will receive \$40/day, lunch, and a marked catalog with their breeds and finals. Stewards will be paid \$25 plus lunch. Please do not deduct these from your entry fees; you will be paid at the end of the show. Preference will be given to TICA certified clerks. Due to the size of the show, we advise you to have an agent show your cat(s).

CHECK-IN: Check-in on Friday & Saturday will be from 9:00 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Judging will begin promptly at 10:00 a.m. Late arrivals must check-in with the Master Clerk and each ring clerk to ensure their entries are marked present. The show hours are from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Friday & Sunday, show will end on Saturday at 7:00 p.m.. [Parade of Champions & Best of the Best will follow Sunday's competition. Plan on attending] No cats may leave the show hall unless permission is obtained from the show manager. No cats may remain in the show hall overnight.

CAGES AND SUPPLIES: A double benching cage (approximately 44"x27"x22") will be used. Four (4) kittens or two (2) cats are permitted in a double cage. If you bring your own cage & require more room, you will need to purchase a grooming space at an additional fee. Please plan on using the cages provided, as grooming spaces will be limited & on a first come, first serve basis. All cages must be covered on three sides, top and bottom. Please bring your own litter pans, cat food and dishes. Litter will be supplied. People food will be available at the Fair Grounds various concession stands. There are **NO "FOR SALE"** entries.

SHOW RULES: By entering, all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges, the show committee, and the TICA show rules. Official show rules may be obtained from TICA, P.O. Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551, and (956) 428-8046. Also see the TICA web site (www.tica.org) for additional rules, forms and information.

REGISTRATION: With the exception of Korats, registration with TICA is not necessary to compete in a cat's first show, but is required for the next show, confirmation of titles and TICA Regional/International scoring and awards.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: This is a non-vetted show. All cats/kittens entering the show hall must be inoculated against Panleukopenia, Rhinotracheitis, Rabies and Calici virus at least 21 days prior to the show. No kitten under 3 calendar months of age will be allowed in the show hall. All cats/kittens must be free of fungus, fleas, ear mites, FELV negative, and not show any signs of illness. All cats/kittens should be bathed and clean. Please clip claws on all four feet. Note: Declawed cats are eligible for competition.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: An official entry form or facsimile must be used for each entry and a completed summary sheet and full payment (U.S. Funds only) must accompany these entry blanks. E-mail or fax entries will be accepted, but will not be officially entered until full payment is received. If payment is not received within 10 days of email/fax entry, entry will become null and void. There will be no one-day entries.
